The young, experimental cultural institution IMAGINE THE CITY develops exemplary new formats at the interface of culture and urban planning in Hamburg's Hafencity in order to integrate artistic perspectives into urban development processes at an early stage and in the long term - and to anchor culture in civil society. By interweaving urban planning and aesthetic strategies, ITC also positions itself in an international context and aims to contribute to current discussions on the role of art and culture for the future development of cities.
